As a member of the Washington State Code Council, Tien seeks to link the built environment with eco-conscious practices while creating opportunities for the future green workforce. Tien holds degrees in architecture and mechanical engineering and is a graduate of the Leadership Tomorrow class of 2008. He is a Lean Six Sigma Green Belt, member of the American Institute of Architects and American Society for Quality.
